Every child who comes to Samaritan Village has a story. And every story is a tragic one. All are stories of abandonment. Each is a story of neglect and many are stories of abuse, some even of

horrible exploitation. They are stories that offer no hope for the future or at best a future that will be lived in the shadow of the trauma they

suffered as a child. But at Samaritan Village, the promise that God gives to every one of us is being realized in the lives of the children growing up here. In Jeremiah 29:11 we are told "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the

Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

New Dorm use and Hospital

We wrote about the new plans for our current three story dorm/medical clinic and the addition of a new three story nospital in our last newsletter. We have some more details about the plan and ways we all can help.

Looking to the Future First, the total cost of the first floor of the new hospital will be \$280,000. This includes the three story building itself along with the completed first floor. It

also includes all the medical equipment, beds, etc. needed to open and operate the hospital.

Once the hospital opens it will continue to provide free medical care for the children and low cost or no cost care for the community. There will also be opportunities for contracts with local companies that will make the hospital its sole provider. The income from these contracts and the community will fund the completion of the remaining two stories of the hospital.

We will continue to use 100% of the funds from sponsors and donors to the orphanage for the care of the children. That will never change.



A CHILD IS returned to Her family

Whenever children are abandoned, there is always a police investigation. Often the investigation continues after the child has been placed at the orphanage. If the mother is located, she is placed into custody. After that, an attempt is made to find a relative who can take the child. This is what happened with Preasures who was



brought to Samaritan Village on March 28th of this year. She was returned to her grandfather the first week of June while her mother remains in jail.
